# 6TH ANNUAL WARRIOR WEEK CAR, TRUCK, AND BIKE SHOW

- Open to Active Duty and retired military personnel, veterans with a DD-214, members of the American Legion, DAV, and VFW (with their membership cards). Participants must show military ID to enter the show area.
- Judging begins at 11:00am. **All show vehicles must be detailed and ready to be judged by 10:30am.** Show area opens at 8:00am for late entries, 9:00am for registered entries. Vehicles will not be permitted to participate if they arrive after 10:30am.
- Judges must have access to all areas of the vehicle, including trunk, interior, or engine compartment if the participant wishes to be judged for that area. Judges are not to touch or open any areas of the vehicle to complete their judging duties. Please have all areas accessible to the judges during that time.
- It is suggested that you be available to the judges during the time that your vehicle is being judged. Judges may have questions for you, or may need your assistance with your vehicle. However, it is NOT required that you talk to the judge unless he/she requests it.
- All entries will be judged with attention to detail, cleanliness, and overall appearance, to include paint, body, interior, engine, tires/wheels, modifications, age of vehicle, and extras. Entries will be judged as fairly and impartially as possible. Remember, this is for fun and to show off your vehicle.
- All vehicles will be classified by the vehicle owner at the time of registration. Please look closely at the registration form for the proper section to choose the appropriate classification to enter your vehicle.
- No vehicles will be moved once they are parked for the show, unless a staff member asks specifically for a vehicle to be moved. This is for safety reasons with the crowds/children present at the show.
- Tie breakers will be decided by the head judge after a short re-evaluation of details. Judges' decision is **final**.
- Displays that are of a disruptive, objectionable, or inappropriate nature, as interpreted by show management, will be removed from the show.
- Show management determines display space assignments.
- No sale of merchandise will be permitted.
- No glass bottles, no alcohol in or on show grounds.
- No live promotional models allowed.
- No dogs or other pets.
- Participants agree to comply with all standards and rules set forth by judges and organizers of Warrior Week Car, Truck, and Bike Show. Participant's failure to comply with such terms, rules and regulations shall entitle organizers to terminate the entrant's current and future participation.
- Participants agree to comply with all pertinent laws, codes, and regulations of municipal or other authorities, which affect the display space.
- No DJ's and/or sound equipment are permitted other than those provided by show management. This includes music coming from participating vehicles. Music must remain within the confines of your space or played at a level not to interrupt the business of surrounding vendors. Specialized lighting also must remain within the confines of your display space.
- No distribution of literature or placement of literature around the venue will be permitted without prior approval of show management.
