BURGLARY AND ROBBERY ALARM ORDINANCES

13-604 – ALARM USER’S PERMIT REQUIRED – All alarm users shall obtain at no cost a permit from the Chief of Police, or his authorized representatives, on or before July 1, 1998. Evidence that such permit has been obtained shall be displayed as closely as possible to the front door of the premises where the alarm system is located. Such permit shall be issued to the owner or occupant of the premises where the alarm system is located and shall not be transferable from one person or organization to another.

13-607 – FALSE ALARMS – Signals from an alarm system which are false are hereby declared to be a public nuisance. If law enforcement records show four (4) or more false alarms within a one (1) period during any calendar year, it shall be deemed a violation if this chapter, provided however, an alarm user who produces documentation of efforts to repair an alarm system during any calendar year shall be deemed in violation of this chapter upon the occurrence of a fifth false alarm thereafter.

13-609 – PENALTY FOR VIOLATION OF THIS CHAPTER

Each alarm user or presiding officer (if the user is not an individual) shall be subject to a maximum fine of twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) for each violation of this chapter.
